

Loto, contemporary charm

Loto brings back to modern taken archetypal shapes.

The sculptural effect of this bowl allows its use in the center of the room thanks to a careful previous project that foresees a freestanding easel rather than a more traditional position against the wall (on an easel or countertop). The large bowl has simple lines, available in two version, with or without the base for the taps, supported a tripod, in wood for the freestanding version, for a result that exalts the pure design and the stage strength of the couple marble-wood.

Two available sizes.

Shapes and materials choices play an interesting game between pattern and color contrasts, and they all emphasize the sensorial qualities of these proposals.
